Identification and Brief Advice Training

In order to reduce the impact of drug and alcohol related harm, training will be available to all Tier 1 staff working in Morecambe, Lancaster, Wyre and Fylde – All sessions are from 10.00 – 4.15 on the dates above.

Attendance is welcomed from the Police, DWP, Local Authority services, Fire and Rescue Services, Health services, Children's Centres, volunteer services – anyone who feels that they come into contact with people that potentially misuse drugs and/or alcohol.

This course seeks to highlight and broaden knowledge around drug and alcohol related issues in an interactive and interesting way, exploring topics such as what is alcohol, what are its effects and what harm can result from misuse? What are drugs, 'how do we identify them' and how can we help people address their substance misuse.

The course will illustrate how you as an individual can contribute to this work by identifying people who need support with their drinking or drug use through the use of a screening tool and up-to date knowledge of local services that can support people.
