### Enabling Others Module

- **Who is this for:**
  1. those interested in becoming a Practice Educator for social work students
  2. those who have had some experience of working with social work students but require further education and training.
- **When:** dates below
- **Where:** the courses will be run at the University of Central Lancashire in Preston
- **What the module covers:** upon completion the candidate will have an understanding of what is required when planning for, managing and assessing a social work student on placement.
- **What do you need to do:** enrol, attend the five taught sessions, undertake independent study, work with a UCLan social work student on placement, complete and pass the assignments (including assessed observations in your work setting).
- **How much time do you have to commit:** The module is equal to 200 hours of learning (relevant to CPD for your GSCC re-registration). You are required to attend the taught sessions and independent study. Each candidate will also support a UCLan social work student on placement.
- **What do you get out of it:**
  - On successfully completing assessed work:
    1. 20 University credits at either Level six (Undergraduate Degree) or level seven (Masters).
    2. You will achieve Stage One of the Practice Educator Professional Standards for Social Work (according to the final draft document November 2010). To top up to Stage Two candidates will need to work with one other student after progression from stage one.
- **Do I enrol on Level 6 or Level 7**

Level six is for candidates who do not hold a degree relevant to social work or social/health care. Level seven is appropriate for candidates who have a minimum of a Bachelor's degree with Honours, with a lower second class degree.
