Please allow me to introduce myself, my name is Sue Faulkner some of you may know me, I was employed by Action for Children in the Lancashire Parenting project, as a Parent/family support worker. My work involved delivering parenting programmes and 1-1 support to families with complex and multiple needs, to work alongside parents communicating with school and other agencies to enable the best for the child and family. I worked for a short time in the Lancaster area before moving to Preston to continue my work with Action for Children in the Preston and South Ribble area. Previously to then I worked at Moorside Primary school for 6 years as a Learning Mentor.
